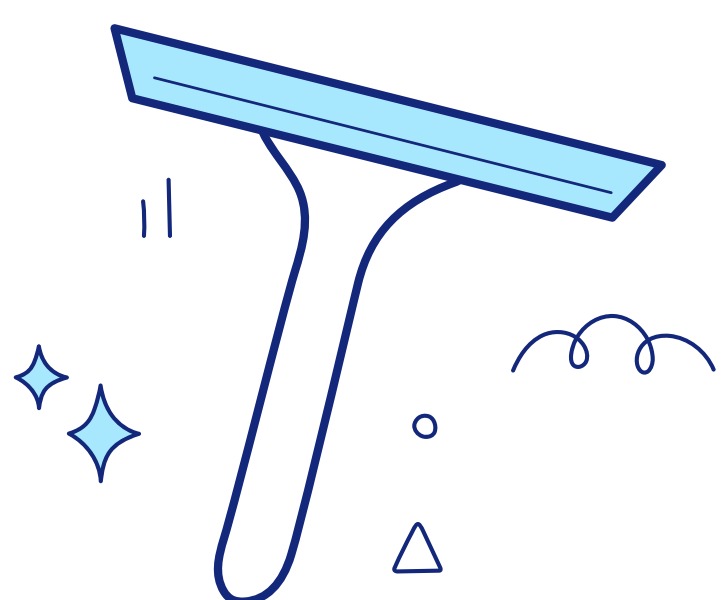

### Measuring Cup

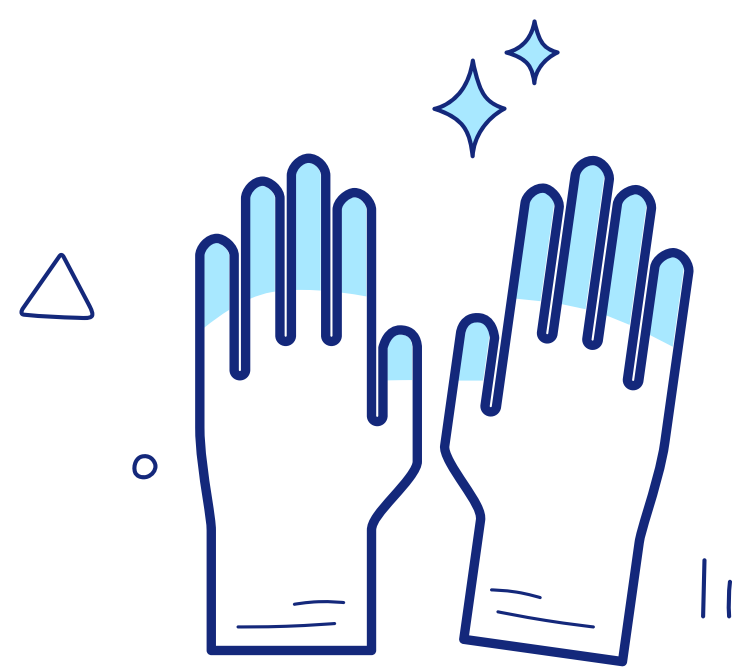
Did you mess up a cleaning solution because you eyeballed the quantities? Keep a measuring cup at hand to get an exact mix.



### Disposable

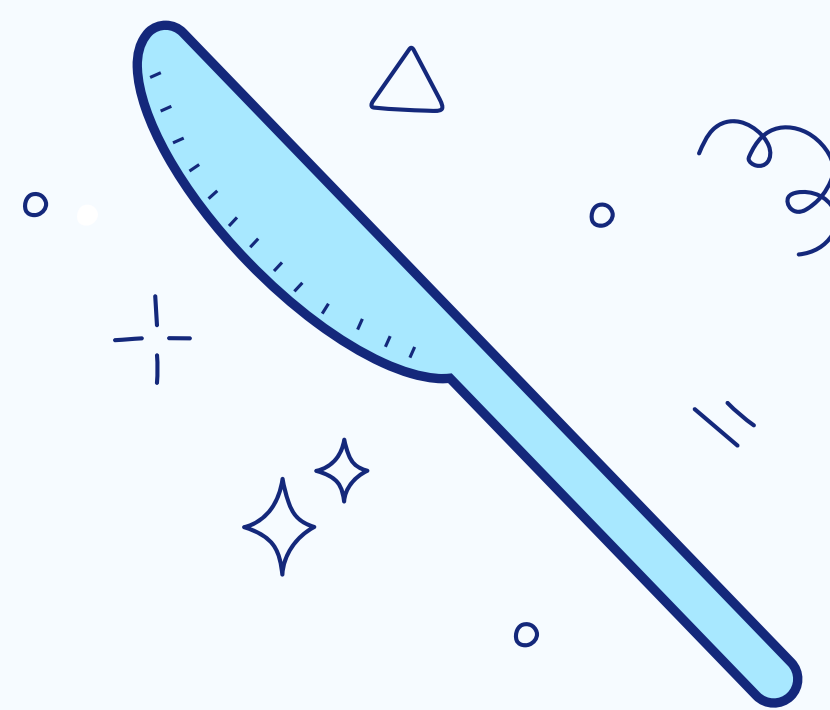
### Gloves
